If you have room in your car for extra passengers would you kindly be at the North York Public Library at 7.30 to pick up any members.

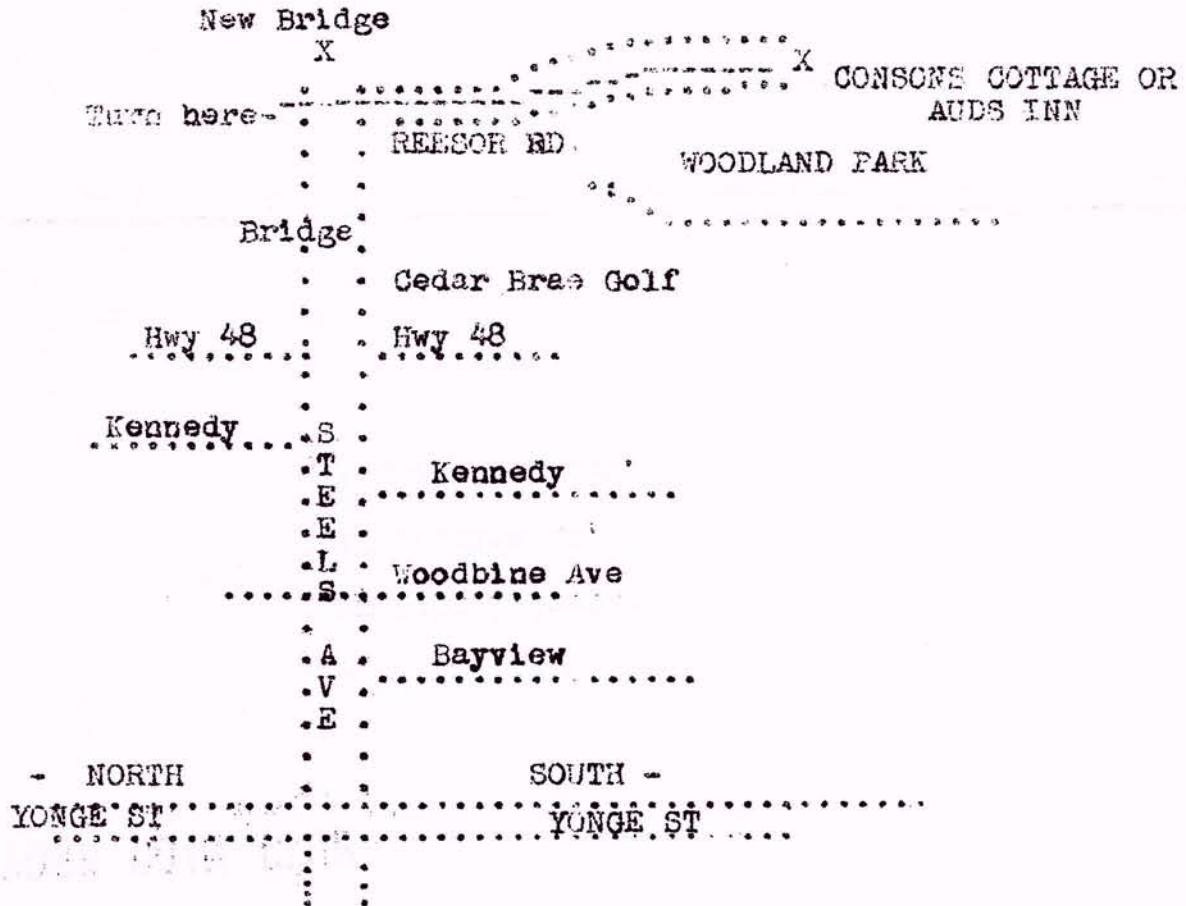
There will be plenty of tables for dealers.
