The title of his address will be NUMISMATICS versus COIN COLLECTING this subject will cover Heraldry as used on English, British and present day coinage of Canada. The guest speaker was introduced by Elizabeth Wyn Wood, he was Mr J.R. von Weiler, a member of the International Federation of Editors of Medals (FIDEM) who spoke on the collecting of medals their size and form also their use as commemorative pieces and as awards. He went on to explain the different methods used in striking medals through the ages, the talk was illustrated by a display of large table medals and small commemorative of Dutch origin.
