### LAST MEETING

40 members and guests were present at the July meeting to enjoy the beautiful coloured slides of varieties of 50¢ and 5¢ pieces produced by Mr Emerson Orser. Included in the showing was a set of the North York Coin Club medals in a case. A few of the club medals are still available in bronze only at \$3.50 to members and \$4.00 to non members.

Displays on view were "varieties of 1951 Silver Dollars" by Mr Ted Merner. A joint display was put on by Mrs Winifred Mather and May Bunnett of the two volumes of "The Medallie Illustrated History of Great Britain and Ireland" plus the folios of illustrations of this work. These books cover almost all commemorative medals struck from William I to the death of George II. Published on instructions of the trustees of the British Museum in 1885, the folios were issued at intervals between the years 1904 and 1911. The books and folios are now out of print. Included in the display was a medal of Admiral Vernon commemorating the capture of Porto Bello with six ships in 1739 according to the reference in the "Medallie Illustrated" there were 48 varieties of this one medal.

Among the guests were Mr & Mrs James Charlton of Canada Coin Exchange. A history of North York Coin Club will appear in the Canadian section of COIN WORLD together with photographs taken by Mr Charlton at the meeting. Watch Coin World for the story of your clubs beginning.
