This meeting is also of special significance since it marks our 50th meeting, and at this time a full attendance is hoped for.

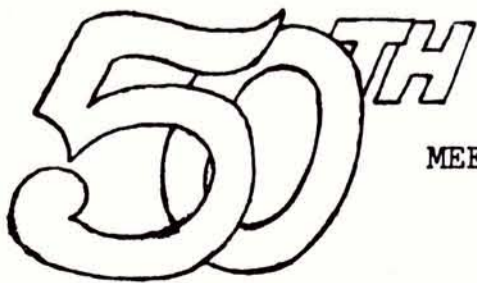
The usual draw for a 1963 Proof-like Mint Set and floor auction will follow.
