For anyone interested in paper money of Canada and did not attend the last meeting, then you missed the best meeting of the year!!!

Mr. Harvey Farrow, your president, delivered an excellent narration to accompany some 70 colour slides on the subject, which were loaned to the club by the Canadian Paper Money Society of Canada.

The slides made up a type set and illustrated an excellent cross-section of rarity, colour and craftsmanship in Canadian art from pre-confederation to date.

Some of the more interesting notes shown was the St. Stephen's bank \$3.00 bill, specimens from the Province of Canada, Dominion of Canada and The Government of Newfoundland. Other notes similar to cheques were shown with the inscription "Payable at Toronto". There were overprints, mistakes, misprints, fold errors, and odd serial numbered bills. Many of the "Broken Banks" which either went defunct or was taken over by another larger bank were also illustrated.

Aside from the monetary worth of each specimen, the beauty of the engraver was shown by depicting almost all facets of Canadian life, such as rural, urban, spiritual, seasonal, which included people, animals, flowers, and mythical beings etc...

The club's thanks to Mr. Fred Jewett, editor of the C. P. M. S's journal and who is also a director on the N. Y. C. C. executive, for the loan of these excellent slides.
