These slides were produced by the Vancouver Numismatic Society, and were loaned to the club by the Canadian Numismatic Association Library in Ottawa. They are being shown in conjunction with C.N.A. month, to exemplify the invaluable service provided by the Canadian Numismatic Association to Canadian numismatists.

The slides cover the tokens and promissory notes issued by The Hudsons Bay Company from 1668 to 1946.
