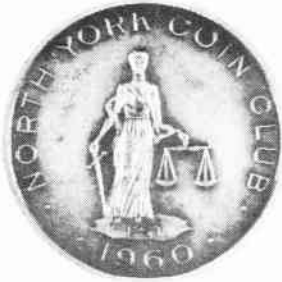
Exhibits for Coin Week Canada were supplied by Stan Clute, Jim Charlton, Fred Jewett, Albert Kasman and George Fraser.
