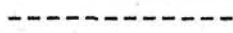

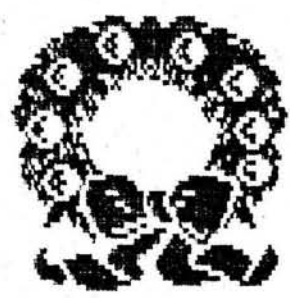

Hence the "Numismatics of the Rebellion of 1837" were able to leave a valuable legacy of this historical event.
