Two varieties of Canadian coins were displayed at this meeting by Kaj Rasmussen; the first a 1958 50 cent piece with center of A in Elizabeth filled. The second coin Mr Rasmussen passed around for our inspection and interest, was another Canadian 50 cent piece, this being a 1943 with a die flaw starting at the bottom of the shield on the reverse of coin and passing through the 9 of date almost ~~xxxxxx~~ through the 4 of date. The two items caused a good deal of interest, and it would be important to know if other collectors have information of the above mentioned.

An informative talk was given by John Shepherd, on Why Die Breaks are Caused. Also a short address was provided by Mrs Louise Graham, on the A.B.C. of Collecting, and the need to read all numismatic literature that is obtainable. A short talk was also given by the Secretary on Coin Scales and Coin Weights, as a side line to numismatics, a complete set of weights and scales of the 18th century were shown.

It was decided to send notification to the C.N.A. Convention Chairman, that a delegate from North York Coin Club would attend the 1960 Convention at Sherbrooke to be appointed from the members present.
