The guest speaker for this meeting is a familiar fellow to everyone at North York. He was one of the founders of the club and was president for two years. Of course, non other than Mr. Ken Bunnett. Mr. Bunnett's topic will be Greek and Roman Coins and he will be illustrating his talk with a number of slides. This should be a very interesting and informative evening for all who attend.

The regular draw for a 1965 Proof-Like mint set will be held, followed by the floor auction.

### LAST MEETING:

Mrs. Graham spoke about the death of Miss. Elizabeth Wyn Wood as a great loss to Art and Numismatics. She mentioned the many plaques, statues, and murals designed by her that are on display throughout Ontario and Canada. A minute of silence was recognized in her favour.

A number of items were presented and discussed before the members.

The first being the library. This library may not be big, but it contains many interesting books, journals, periodicals, and official publications issued over the past ten years or so. Accompanying this bulletin is a complete listing of all books in the library and the members are invited to borrow these at any meeting for research or just reading pleasure.

Another item that was brought up, was the use of a trading post bulletin board to advertise any items you need for your collection or you would like to sell or trade.

Finally, the need for more member participation in club meetings. All that was suggested here is that a member would bring one or two items from his or her collection and talk about it for five to ten minutes. This would give the member a little more experience in talking with fellow numismatists and add more variety of the whole meeting. The topic does not necessarily have to be on a coin or note, but could be about a numismatic experience, or a "pet" project now being researched etc. Mr. Safer has volunteered for this meeting, so it should be quite good.

The guest speaker for last meeting was member, Mr. John Cloran. Mr. Cloran's topic was on Canadian Patterns: those coins that were designed but never intentionally released to the public. He referred to items such as the 1911 Canadian Silver Dollar, of which only three or four were struck and only one is in the hands of a collector. The obverse, although designed for 1911, still had the words "DEI GRATA" in the inscription and was later used for the 1936 Silver Dollar.

Mr. Cloran went on to the 1928 ten dollar gold piece, of which none were struck.

Next he talked about the Pattern-Proof Dollar of 1939 in which he mentions the frosted relief, clear field, sharp border and fine edges. Truly a beautiful coin.

Finally he mentions the 1949 Canadian (Commorative) Silver Dollar.

A question period concluded Mr. Cloran's fine talk.

March is traditionally the month of Leprechauns and shamrocks and it was only fitting that the bulletin be printed in green!
