LAST MEETING: The Christmas meeting was held on Tuesday December 29, 1970, and was very successful. There was music, food, displays, a mini chess tournament, and a donation auction. The displays exhibited were:

MICHAEL ZIGLER: The bank notes of Oceania including those of Australia, New Zealand and Fiji, and also Australian Asterisk notes.

In the double raffle, Mrs. Ford, a guest, won a 1964 silver dollar, and Mr. Farrow won a 1969 C.N.A. convention medal in bronze. Mr. Farrow redonated the medal, and it was raffled off again to be won by Mrs. G. Miller.

In the Mini Chess tournament, with two competitors, the winner was Mr. Allyn Miller, a guest, and the loser was your editor, Michael Zigler.

Also at the December meeting, distinguished member Mr. Jewett spoke on the Canadian Holey dollars of P.E.I. and how they compared and differed with the Australian Holey dollar exhibited by Mrs. Miller.

The donation auction featured such diverse items as "The world's smallest coin", a Halifax bus ticket, a \$1 bill with a palindromic serial number, and cookies. The December meeting also contained discussion of the N.Y.C.C.'s coming "COIN SHOW, COIN SALE AND WHITE ELEPHANT SALE"
