of the North York Coin Club was held on February 23, 1971. The meeting contained discussion on the coming coin show, and the various chairmen gave their reports.

"AN INTRODUCTION TO THE FASCINATION OF PAPER MONEY" by Harold Don Allen, and loaned to the club by the International Bank Note Society. Some of the interesting slides included a twenty shilling note from the Eritish West African Currency Board issued at Lagos; a one, Balboa note from Panama, and some Canadian notes. Needless to say, the Canadian notes attracted the most attention. Many people saw the devils face in the queen's hair for the first time, on a slide of an early 1954 note. Hoger Fox and Michael Zigler both spoke briefly on certain aspects relating to the Canadian notes on the slides such as: Asterisks; sgrial numbers; plate numbers; counterfeiting and the banknote companies. Some of the scenes on the reverse sides of the notes were identified. All members present enjoyed the slides, and I am sure that everyone learned something.

Two displays were entered at the meeting. Mr. Strong displayed a Nontreal and Lachine Railroad Token, along with his extensive research. Fichael Zigler's display was entitled The Dank Notes of the World: Decimalization.
