Thats inflation. George Fraser distributed souvenir notes to commemorate the 20th. year, and a decorated cake was served during the coffee break.

The highlight of the evening however was Dr. Marvin Kay's presentation of "Medicine in Numismatics". Dr. Kay showed colored slides of medical medals, coins, -tokens and banknotes, illustrating his interesting talk on Physicians on Medals and others who made contributions to medicine. Louis Pasteur, the bacteriaologist, Pierre & Marie Curie, pioneers in research on radio-activity, Alexander Graham Bell, whose invention of the telephone came from his efforts to help deaf people. Dr. Kay's facinating subject revealed medals commemorating hospitals, nurses medals, Red cross medals, Life-saving medals, Coins with medical themes, Bank notes with Portraits of Physicians, Chiropractors, Druggists, Radiologists, War medals, and private hospital medals, all with a medical theme. Dr. Kay also displayed many of the Medals shown.

Harvey Farrow thanked Dr. Kay and presented him with an honorary membership for a year.
