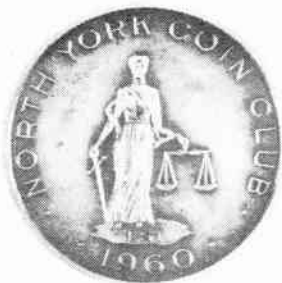
A report on the Collingwood coin show was given by President Harvey Farrow.
