4-The \$40.00 raised in auction from donations by Jim Charlton will be used to provide very a

special and very generous Xmas gift for each Junior Member of the NYCC.

5-The NYCC will be the Host Club for the ONA/87 Convention, April 3, 4 & 5, 1987.

6-Membership dues will remain at the current level.

Harvey Farrow introduced the Guest Speaker for the evening, Dr. Marvin Kay. Marvin spoke on several topics, including Autographs in Numismatics. Under this heading, he displayed about twenty books on numismatics which were autographed by the respective authors. Marvin seemed especially proud of a book autographed by the Toronto sculptress, Dora de Pedery Hunt.

Also on display were half a dozen of her metallic sculptures, all autographed by Hunt. Then Marvin showed a series of slides of CNA convention medals, and other coins and medals that he has acquired during his extensive travels in Canada and abroad. He generously donated, to the auction, a copy of an important numismatic textbook, the 4th edition of Krause's World Paper Money. And for the Door Draw, he donated a large bronze medal for Tourism in Israel.

Then Marvin wanted to give away a set of his personal numismatic items, which included

two bronze medals, four woods and his 20th anniversary souvenir card. Since so many hands went up asking for this prize, he announced a contest, open to all members of the NYCC.
