In her opening remarks SUSAN advised members that, through her association with the Canadian Conservation Institute in Ottawa, she had been able to make an indepth investigation into what to look for in good coin and paper note holders and what they should be made of. Very briefly, they should be of inert and stable material (Mylar is best), be non abrasive, of acid free paper (non buffered), be pollution free and colour fast. SUSAN cautioned against the use of cellulose acetate and PVC holders. If materials are not identified, then investigate on your own. Smell for chemicals. All results are available at C.C.I. Susan also demonstrated a simple test that can be performed at home. In conclusion she stressed your coins are worth a little work on your part. RON ZELK graciously thanked SUSAN for her excellent presentation and presented her with an Honorary Membership for 1989 and a members name button. THANK YOU SUSAN. (ALSO, thanks goes to JOHN REGITKO for making up our new name tag buttons.)

During the break everyone enjoyed COFFEE and COOKIES served by TED BOXALL.
