The designs worked through from simple initials, flowers and leaves to elaborate monograms, dates of occasions, names of givers and receivers, romantic symbols and lengthy messages. The single tokens also progressed to multiple sets. Not only were the examples interesting but the interpretations could be quite fascinating. Love Tokens were popular from the 1600's to 1909 with brief appearances during the 1st and 2nd World Wars. Don was heartily thanked by Ron and was presented with a Speaker's Certificate and a Membership Card.
